

**By JONATHAN SNYDER** After two hours of deliberation, the Wells County Area Plan Commission motioned to continue a rezoning petition for Almco Steel Products.

Jim Almdale and Gary Aschliman represented Almco Steel, which is looking to rezone 38.82 acres of land at 1115 West Lancaster St., west of its main plant,

from an agricultural residential zone to a heavy industrial zone. Almdale stated that the rezoning will lay the groundwork for future projects for the company.

Area Plan Commission board member Jarrod Hahn noted that there are no immediate plans drawn up for the property; Almco will still have to get approval for building plans.

Once the board opened the meeting for public comments about the petition, all of the approximately 40 people in attendance stood against it. A petition against the zoning appeal with over 190 signatures was also presented to The News-Banner. Once a concerned member of the public was finished, applause followed from the other members in atten-

dance.

Susan Grove opened the public comments, stating that Almco's plan does not pay reasonable regard to any of the five requirements for the APC to pass a rezoning petition. Grove stated that the area has severe flooding issues affecting Oak Street. She also said the increased truck traffic from Almco's expansion poses a safety

risk for children at the bus stop corner of Lancaster and Baldwin streets. Dallas Moser also cited the lack of sidewalks in the area as an already hazardous venture for children walking to the bus stop with or without the increased traffic.

Grove also felt the lack of an immediate plan for the site was a lack of regard for responsible (Continued on Page 2)

> turkeys are called poults, the 10 to 15 eggs in a nest is called a clutch, a gobbler is a male turkey, one bird can have from 5,000 to 6,000 feathers, turkeys eat plants (and bugs when they are babies), gizzards allow turkeys to eat acorns and feather patterns are different for birds in different area.

The Federation is divided into five areas with this area being in the Eastern area. (Others areas are Osceola (Florida), Rio Grande, Merriam's (Rocky Mountain) and Gould's (Mexico/New Mexico).

# **Kehoe Park will not** be a part of DORA

Kehoe Park will not be included in a proposed Designated Outdoor Recreation Area in downtown Bluffton.

DORAs, created by the state last year, allow people to hold and consume alcoholic beverages within the area boundary. There is a drafted proposal to create a DORA for downtown Bluffton to promote downtown businesses and events, as well as simplify the event permitting process. The proposal is still in the early stages.

Superintendent Brandy Fiechter said it was "very kind of them to make the offer" to include Kehoe Park but believed it might overcomplicate the park's current event bartending. The board expressed similar sentiments and said they could reconsider after seeing feedback or potential implementation.

The board approved two change orders, adding underd-rains in the pickleball court at Lancaster Park for \$8,300 and \$650 to pave asphalt millings on (Continued on Page 2)

# Mental health summit highlights mobile crisis teams growth

Non-police mobile crisis teams are now responding to mental health crises in 59 Indiana counties, increasing access to mental health care and relieving the burden on medical providers and law

SEATTLE (AP) — The United States granted the Makah Indian Tribe in Washington state a long-sought waiver Thursday that helps clear the way for its first sanctioned whale hunts since 1999 and sets the stage for renewed clashes with animal rights activists.

The Makah, a tribe of 1,500 people on the northwestern tip of the Olympic Peninsula, is the only Native American tribe with a treaty that specifically mentions a right to hunt whales. But it has faced more than two decades of court challenges, bureaucratic hearings and scientific review as it seeks to resume hunting for gray whales.

The decision by NOAA Fisheries grants a waiver under the Marine Mammal Protection Act, which otherwise forbids harming marine mammals. It allows the tribe to hunt up to 25 Eastern North Pacific gray whales over 10 years, with a limit of two to three per year. There are roughly 20,000 whales in that population.

The tribe celebrated the decision but said it took far too long.

"Whaling remains central to the identity, culture, subsistence, and spirituality of the Makah people, and we regard the Gray Whale as sacred," Makah Tribal

Council Chairman Timothy J. Greene Sr. said in a written statement. "In the time since our last successful hunt in 1999, we have lost many elders who held the knowledge of our whaling customs, and another entire generation of Makahs has grown up without the ability to exercise our Treaty right or experience the connections and benefits of whaling that our ancestors secured for us."

The hunts will be timed in an effort to avoid harming endangered Western North Pacific gray whales that sometimes visit the area - about 200 to 300 remain - as well as a group of about 200 graywhales that generally spend summer and fall feeding along the Northwest coast.

Nevertheless, some hurdles remain. The tribe must enter into a cooperative agreement with the agency under the Whaling Convention Act, and it must obtain a permit to hunt, a process that involves a monthlong public comment period.

Animal rights advocates, who have long opposed whaling, could also challenge NOAA's decision in court. DJ Schubert, a senior wildlife biologist with the Washington, D.C.-based Animal Welfare Insti-

SEA 1 aimed to improve Hoosiers' access to mental health care. The law required the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction to maintain the 988 suicide and crisis hotline, mobile assessment teams and crisis stabilization units. It also reauthorized the Indiana Behavioral Health Commission.

Before SEA 1 went into effect, mobile crisis teams were responding to mental health crises in just 16 Indiana counties. Potts said Indiana also now has four call centers and one text center to respond to 988 crisis hotline calls.

Legislators allocated \$100 million for the program in the 2023 state budget but the IBHC estimated the project to cost around \$130 million a year when it fully matured. On June 4, however, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services accepted Indiana (Continued on Page 2)

### Supreme Court preserves access to abortion medication

WASHINGTON (AP) - The Supreme Court on Thursday unanimously preserved access to a medication that was used in nearly two-thirds of all abortions in the U.S. last year, in the court's first abortion decision since conservative justices overturned Roe v. Wade two years ago.

abortion opponents lacked the legal right to sue over the federal Food and Drug Administration's approval of the medication, mifepristone, and the FDA's subsequent actions to ease access to it. The case had threatened to restrict access to mifepristone across the country, including in states where abortion remains legal.

Abortion is banned at all stages of pregnancy in 14 states, and after

about six weeks of pregnancy in three others, often before women realize they're pregnant.

Justice Brett Kavanaugh, who was part of the majority to overturn Roe, wrote for the court on Thursday that "federal courts are the wrong forum for addressing the plaintiffs' concerns about FDA's actions."

The opinion underscored the stakes of the 2024 election and

the possibility that an FDA commissioner appointed by Republican Donald Trump, if he wins the White House, could consider tightening access to mifepristone, including prohibiting sending it through the mail.

Kavanaugh's opinion managed to unite a court deeply divided over abortion and many other divisive social issues by employing a minimalist approach that focused

solely on the technical legal issue of standing and reached no judgment about the FDA's actions. Kavanaugh's seven "pro-life" references to abortion opponents may have been the only language in his opinion that revealed anything of his views on abortion.

While praising the decision, President Joe Biden signaled Democrats will continue to campaign (Continued on Page 2)

After public comments finished, Almdale stated that while there is no immediate plan, the company has considered buffer and shielding around the property and the location of the expansion.

sion of Hale Street going west and turning back south towards Lancaster Street, stating that it could help divert the truck traffic away. Commission member John Schuhmacher asked about the realistic expectations for a new street - Lautzenheiser said that unless alternative funding can be secured, Almco would be the main benefactor in the road's construction.

The board also stated that plans to address drainage and safety problems would have to be shown in a development plan. The lack of immediate plans for the rezoned property gave the commission reason to make the petition more malleable. Lautzenheiser asked Almdale if a partial rezoning of the property would be acceptable, which Almdale was receptive to.

Hahn also noted that the property could have business restrictions placed on it, preventing the area from becoming something like a landfill or slaughterhouse in the future. Hahn stated that the commission has to look at the potential uses for the new zoning, and the restrictions will prevent the area from getting a more unsightly business.

The petition was given a 60-day continuance and will be revisited at the board's Aug. 1 meeting.

The commission also approved a building addition, sidewalks and parking for Daniel Dubach at 505 South Main St. in Bluffton. Dubach's 600-square-foot addition on the south side of his business will have new parking spaces along Central Avenue. The plans have been signed off by the heads of the electric, fire, wastewater, water, building and street departments after some adjustments were made to ensure parking did not encroach on the nearest sidewalk.

The commission also cleared two violations for Sarah Swinford and Thomas Reinhard. Reinhard's junk violation has been cleared from 10017 South 200 West in Keystone, and Swinford has removed two sections of fence encroaching on her neighbor's property at 527 South Marion St. in Bluffton

He noted that while the Eastern North Pacific gray whale population appears healthy now, it has fluctuated wildly in recent years, and no one knows how the whales will fare as climate change continues to affect the Arctic. Scientists estimate that as much as 40% of the population died off from 2018 to last year before it began to recover.

"We completely respect the tribe's cultural practices and traditions," Schubert said. "We just fundamentally disagree that they need to hunt whales to continue those traditions. We hope that as this decision-making process plays out, perhaps the Makah Tribe and the government could reconsider the need to hunt whales and advocate for protection instead of persecution."

Archeological evidence shows that Makah hunters in cedar canoes killed whales for sustenance from time immemorial, a practice that ceased only in the early 20th century after commercial whaling vessels depleted the population.

By 1994, the Eastern Pacific gray whale population had rebounded, and they were removed from the endangered species list.

They took to the water in 1998 but didn't succeed until the next year, when they harpooned a gray whale from a hand-carved cedar canoe. A tribal member in a motorized support boat killed it with a high-powered rifle to minimize its suffering.

It was the tribe's first successful hunt in 70 years.

The hunts drew protests from animal rights activists, who sometimes threw smoke bombs at the whalers and sprayed fire extinguishers into their faces. Others veered motorboats between the whales and the tribal canoes to interfere with the hunt. Authorities seized several vessels and made arrests.

After animal rights groups sued, the 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals overturned federal approval of the tribe's whaling plans. The court found that the tribe needed to obtain a waiver under the 1972 Marine Mammal Protection Act.

Eleven Alaska Native communities in the Arctic have such a waiver for subsistence hunts, allowing them to kill bowhead whales even though bowheads are listed as endangered.

The Makah Tribe applied for a waiver in 2005. The process repeatedly stalled as new scientific information about the whales and the health of their population was uncovered.

Marjorie Dannenfelser, president of SBA Pro-Life America, expressed disappointment with the ruling, but trained her fire on Democrats. "Joe Biden and the Democrats are hell-bent on forcing abortion on demand any time for any reason, including DIY mail-order abortions, on every state in the country," Dannenfelser said.

About two-thirds of U.S. adults oppose banning the use of mifepristone, or medication abortion, nationwide, according to a KFF poll conducted in February. About one-third would support a nationwide ban.

The high court is separately considering another abortion case, about whether a federal law on emergency treatment at hospitals overrides state abortion bans in rare emergency cases in which a pregnant patient's health is at serious risk.

More than 6 million people have used mifepristone since 2000. Mifepristone blocks the hormone progesterone and primes the uterus to respond to the contraction-causing effect of a second drug, misoprostol. The two-drug regimen has been used to end a pregnancy through 10 weeks gestation.

Jillian Phillips, of North Brookfield, Massachusetts, took mifepristone after she suffered a miscarriage eight years ago. She eventually passed the remains of her nine-week pregnancy, which she buried in a memorial garden.

"It should have never been something we had to win," Phillips, a 42-yearold mother of three, said. "These are decisions that should be happening in a medical exam room, not courtrooms."

Health care providers have said that if mifepristone is no longer available or is too hard to obtain, they would switch to using only

misoprostol, which is somewhat less effective in ending pregnancies.

Biden's administration and drug manufacturers had warned that siding with abortion opponents in this case could undermine the FDA's drug approval process beyond the abortion context by inviting judges to second-guess the agency's scientific judgments. The Democratic administration and New York-based Danco Laboratories, which makes mifepristone, argued that the drug is among the safest the FDA has ever approved.

The decision "safeguards access to a drug that has decades of safe and effective use," Danco spokeswoman Abigail Long said in a statement.

The plaintiffs in the mifepristone case, anti-abortion doctors and their organizations, argued in court papers that the FDA's decisions in 2016 and 2021 to relax restrictions on getting the drug were unreasonable and "jeopardize women's health across the nation."



### Indiana Court of Appeals weighs constitutionality of handgun restrictions for indicted persons

The Indiana Court of Appeals heard arguments Tuesday on whether prohibiting individuals under indictment from carrying a handgun violates the Second Amendment.

Arthur Moore believes the state violated his right to bear arms when it charged him with a misdemeanor for unlawful carrying of a handgun while he had other pending criminal charges.

However, an attorney for the state argued the statute used to convict Moore is consistent with the nation's historical tradition of regulating firearms and was necessary to protect public safety.

#### **Restricting rights based on allegations**

At the center of Tuesday's hearing was an Indiana statute that prohibits a person under indictment from carrying a handgun in public. Moore's attorney, Joel Schumm, said the state restricted his client's Second Amendment right based on allegations that he committed a crime, rather than a conviction.

Moore was involved in a car accident Dec. 19, 2022. According to court filings, police found a handgun, magazine and a loose round of ammunition in Moore's car when they responded to the scene. At the time of the accident, Moore had already been charged with three separate Level 6 felonies for sexual battery, dealing marijuana and maintaining a common nuisance, but had not been convicted.

Prosecutors used the statute to charge and later convict Moore with a Class A misdemeanor carrying a one-year jail sentence.

Moore previously filed a motion to dismiss the handgun charge in May 2023, but a lower trial court denied this motion. He filed a notice of appeal in September 2023, and asked the appeals court to vacate his conviction. Deputy Attorney General Ellen Meilaender said Indiana used judicially determined probable cause to charge Moore with having the handgun in this case. However, Court of Appeals Judge Paul Felix – who oversaw the hearing along with Judges Elizabeth Tavitas and Dana Kenworthy – pointed out the statute does not explicitly require judicial review and determination to restrict a person under indictment from carrying a handgun.

### Senator's letter critical of hospital association casts shadow on 2025 health care discussions

**Indiana Capital Chronicle** A high-ranking senator accused the state's leading hospital lobbying organization of being "responsible for the gradual breakdown of trust" between lawmakers and hospital systems after the most recent legislative session, as documented in a four-page letter shared with the Indiana Capital Chronicle

Sen. Chris Garten, a Republican from Charlestown, wrote that some legislators had described the Indiana Hospital Association as "arrogant" and "disingenuous."

The letter, addressed to the IHA's board of directors, named former organization president Brian Tabor, who stepped down earlier this year. In a statement, Tabor maintained that his decision predated the March letter and wasn't related to Garten's comments.

The sometimes brash Senate majority floor leader has built a reputation for grilling various state agencies and others on regulatory details and project costs, most notably with the Indiana Gaming Commission. More recently, he questioned licensing delays and welcome center expenses

House Enrolled Act 1004 in 2023, tracking hospital pricing compared to Medicare prices, elicited pushback from Tabor and others.

"My colleagues and I met weekly with representatives from different hospitals and/ or IHA to discuss their concerns about the policy we were implementing. Amidst the multiple versions of the bill and several amendments, I consistently gave IHA the opportunity to review language before it was shared with my legislative colleagues to provide your organization with time to submit feedback because I believe their intentions to be pure, despite that fact that conversations between IHA and other members of my caucus had grown contentious," Garten wrote in the letter.

Garten said people on both sides of the issue made concessions but he was "taken aback" by IHA's mass emails and public messaging following the bill's ultimate passage.

Though the organization has consistently downplayed research from the RAND Corp. ranking Indiana's hospital prices as among the nation's most expensive, Garten said IHA has used RAND research to support other causes.

"For many in my caucus,

ing that a staffer worked behind the scenes to ensure bills weren't heard in committee without consulting Garten.

The proposals would have given third party administrators and pharmacy benefit managers a fiduciary duty to insurance sponsors and prohibited physician compensation for in-system referrals, respectively. House Bill 1327 would have required health care entities to report a breakdown of their ownership data.

On Senate Bill 9, Garten said he "accommodated many of their requests" in bill amendments, including defining "health care entity" and "acquisition" alongside confidentiality requirements. The underlying bill, which passed, requires health systems notify the Office of Attorney General of a planned merger or acquisition.

"I believed that these edits ... would extend across the hallway when SB 9 was in the House, and yet IHA spearheaded a coordinated effort to kill the bill once they felt my attention was diverted elsewhere. This is disingenuous behavior and bad business," Garten wrote. "Let me be clear,

I have no issue with IHA (or any other group) voicing opposition for legislation that they feel is counterproductive to the success of their industry. In fact, I welcome it - stakeholder input directly correlates to better bills for Hoosiers. That is not the issue here."

courage this type of behavior," Garten wrote. He concluded by empha-

sizing a commitment to working with hospitals to lower health care costs, saying that he had great conversations with individual hospitals.

#### Three months later

Garten said in an interview that the legislature's relationship with IHA has improved since sending the letter.

"As I continue to navigate the health care space, I found it more and more difficult to really have a very candid conversation with folks on the other side of some of these issues ... For me, that's key," Garten said. "... I remain open and optimistic about 2025 and the upcoming session and, frankly, the already improved communication between legislation and hospitals and the leadership at Indiana Hospital Association.

"I think we all share the same goals: we want to deliver good quality health care to Hoosiers at the most competitive prices possible. And you know, maybe we're going to have some debates along the way on how we get there, but I think the goals are shared goals."

An IHA statement from current leadership noted the role it plays in crafting legislative proposals related to hospitals and voicing concerns about potential actions. "IHA and the 170 hospitals we represent have a long-standing mission of providing high quality care to all Hoosiers 24 hours a day, 7 days a week," board chair Steve Holman said. Holman is also the president and CEO of Union Health in Terre Haute.

We have a presumption of innocence until proven guilty," Tavitas said. "How do you reconcile that?"

The three judges questioned Schumm about if his client sought a facial challenge - where the appellant argues the statute is unconstitutional under all circumstances - or an as-applied challenge, where the court could deem the statute's application to Moore's specific case unconstitutional. Schumm said he was seeking an as-applied challenge, but that there are still constitutional issues with the regulation.

"This is a very targeted challenge to a very broad provision," Schumm said.

#### Historical tradition of regulating firearms

Meilaender said Indiana Code is consistent with founding-era "surety laws." According to the South Carolina Law Review, colonial surety laws allowed an individual, who others think is likely to "breach the peace" while carrying a weapon, to appear in front of a justice of the peace. If the judge thought the individual was likely to breach the peace, they could require a surety bond. If the individual broke the requirements of the bond, they could face a jail sentence or other punishment.

However, Moore's attorney argued this is not an accurate historical comparison for his conviction, since the surety laws allowed the accused person to simply post a bond to carry a handgun — an option not afforded under Indiana Code.

Schumm also said a pending felony charge does not automatically mean Moore is dangerous. He argued the state did not consider Moore's individual case to determine his "dangerousness" - instead it relied on the blanket restriction - and that he has not been accused of violent conduct.

Meilaender pushed back on the argument that Moore's crimes were "low-level felonies," especially his Level 6 felony charge for sexual assault.

"These are violent crimes," Meilaender said.

Schumm also said the code prevents Moore from carrying a handgun for self-defense in his car.

"Self-defense is so important to Hoosiers," Schumm said.

Meilaender, on the other hand, said Indiana Code allows Moore to still have a handgun at home and does not prevent him from carrying other weapons, including a rifle, for self-defense.

There is no time limit for the Court of Appeals judges to issue a decision in the case.

during a lengthy State Budget Committee meeting.

In an interview, however, Garten struck a more conciliatory tone. Both sides were quick to emphasize a continued commitment to working together.

But the exchange casts a shadow on the 2025 legislative session.

Lawmakers plan to tackle health care pricing, ongoing Medicaid expenses and potentially the oft-debated Hospital Assessment Fee. Hospitals would like to alter the fee's current structure, which offsets Healthy Indiana Plan 2.0 expenses, in a way that they say will benefit both health systems and state government.

#### **Contents of the letter**

Garten has spearheaded several legislative efforts related to hospitals and also chaired the interim Health Care Cost Oversight Task Force, which relied upon and utilized testimony from IHA. He was the Senate sponsor on a disputed proposal that he cited in his letter.

this was indicative of the type of games they had seen IHA play in the past, but for me, it was the first real signal of organizational insincerity – I absolutely took note," he wrote.

Garten's letter indicates that the perceived "hypocritical messaging" on RAND was a topic of a "candid conversation" between he and Tabor on August 7, 2023, prior to meetings of the health care costs task force.

Both parties "committed to moving forward on a good note," Garten wrote, which he said he demonstrated by granting early access to committee agendas and limiting the publication of certain data related to hospital reporting.

The final committee report seeded four bills during the 2024 session, one of which became law: Senate Bill 9. The unsuccessful proposals include Senate Bill 257, Senate Bill 258 and House Bill 1327.

Senate Bills 257 and 258 were shared in advance with IHA staff, Garten said, add-



Instead, he said that his experience with IHA's representatives was not uncommon among lawmakers but that such repeated instances prevented the two parties from having "honest, productive conversation for the betterment of Hoosiers and those who choose to do business in our great state."

"There is a deep divide between legislators and hospitals because of the way IHA continues to conduct itself, and it would go a long way toward mending that relationship if the board and each hospital would dis-

### Father's Day: A 1974 plumbing disaster

In 1974, when I was 11, I flushed an apple core down the toilet. You see, my father had remodeled

our basement into a family room with a powder room.

Always looking to save a buck — he had six kids to feed on one income - he bought the cheapest toilet he could find.

It never did work right, and since we couldn't afford a plumber, my father spent much of his spare time unclogging it.

Armed with this knowledge, then, it's remarkable I did what I did.

One Sunday morning, after chomping on a large Washington apple, I lay on the family room couch, too lazy to get up and properly dispose of it.

I noticed, some 12 feet away, that the toilet lid was up. In a moment of insanity, I aimed the core at the toilet and flicked my wrist. The core floated majestically in the air, a perfect trajectory, then landed in the center of the bowl with a satisfying "kir-plunk!"

I later flushed it and never gave it another thought - until a few months later when another clogging was reported.

As fate would have it, this happened on a Sunday morning, as I lay on the couch, holding another Washington apple core. I watched television, while my father fought to free the clog.

But nothing would free it. The plunger failed, but not before he was soaking wet. Two jars of Drano had no effect. Even the plumber's snake, which my father borrowed from our neighbors when all other measures failed, would not dislodge the mother of all clogs.

In a fit of rage, my father unbolted the toilet from the floor. In one mighty heave, he lifted it off its mount and set it in front of the television.

He knelt before the black hole in the floor. He reached his mighty paw inside, then his forearm, then his biceps.

His head was pressed hard against the cold, wet linoleum, sweat dripping off his nose, the veins in his temples about to explode.

His eyes lit up.

He had something.

He carefully removed his biceps, his forearm and then his paw.

He was on his knees now staring at his clenched fist. He slowly unpeeled his large, grimy fingers.

In the center of his palm, there it was: A black, rotten apple core.

I could go into detail about his incredible reaction how he ran through the house shouting, "Who the hell flushed an apple core down the toilet?

I could describe the shock and horror he felt when he discovered that his only son and only hope in carrying on the family name was the idiot who did it.

But I won't. I will tell you I was paralyzed with fear, a fear born out of respect.

My father loved me and wanted the best for me. He



# European 'far right' issues a stinging rebuke to elites

"The far right made big gains in European elections," reads the Associated Press headline on last week's European Parliament elections. Lest you wonder why you should dread gains by the "far right," the lead sentence of the article notes that the EU has "roots in the defeat of Nazi Germany and fascist Italy.'

For many readers, that juxtaposition is a reminder of the sharp rise in Nazi party percentages in Weimar Republic elections from 3% in 1928 to 18% in 1930, 33% and 37% in 1932, and 43% in 1933.

So is fascist dictatorship on the rise in Europe once again? No, and for multiple reasons.

First, European voters usually don't take European Parliament elections seriously. The parliament can only amend or veto legislation passed by the nonelected European Commission and thus is mostly a talking shop. Turnout in EU elections has usually been well below that in national elections, and in many countries, voters typically cast protest votes in the knowledge that the winners will have only limited ability to set policy.

Second, the gains for the supposed "far-right" parties can easily be overstated. The Identity and Democracy Party increased from 49 seats to 62, and the nonaligned, not all of which is classed as "far right," increased from 62 to 102. That sounds like a big shift, but "far-right" parties still hold only a small minority of the parliament's 720 seats.

Third, and most importantly, the "far-right" parties don't stand for anything like Hitler's Nazis or Mussolini's fascists. Even the Brothers of Italy party, members of which have praised Mussolini, is now solidly committed to constitutional democracy. Its leader, Giorgia Meloni, has been Italy's prime minister since Oct. 2022, and it's no more totalitarian than Italy's center-left Democrats, which has historical roots in the Communist Party.

The losers in the EU elections are the Green, pro-EU, Left and Socialist parties. European and American iournalists, imbibing the assumptions of vulgar Marx ism or American New Dealers, have long assumed voters use their votes to grab others' money and that their natural response to discontent is to seek economic redistribution. But in post-welfare-state Europe, redistribution has gone about as far as it can go - or at least not many voters seem to want it to go further. Protest voters are unhappy about other aspects of the status quo. One reason, writes The New York Times' David Leonhardt, is "because mainstream parties have dismissed public opinion on a major problem: the enormous rise of

immigration."

Or, as maverick conservative Andrew Sullivan put it, over the last decade, "in response to a volatile public mood, Western elites actually intensified their policy of importing millions of people from the developing world to replace their insufficiently diverse and declining domestic populations."

As a result, 19% of Germany's population is foreign-born, as is 15% of Spain's and 13% of France's, with many offspring of previous immigrants living in suburban high-rise ghettoes.

Academics and journalists, puzzled that modest-income voters don't demand eco-

nomic redistribution, tend to ascribe unease about immigration to racism or "status anxiety." Allegedly bigoted voters just don't like dark-skinned people or fear losing their "white privilege."

But there's a better explanation: Too many of the immigrants there are committing violent crimes or are violently trying to impose what Europeans regard as their oppressive religious restrictions on native European young women and gay men. Or massacre journalists who run cartoons of the prophet.

Similar increases in immigration from culturally hostile backgrounds help explain why Britain's Conservatives are about to be swept from power after 14 years and why, despite low unemployment, President Joe Biden is trailing in the polls.

You don't have to be racist or anxious about your status to be upset if you face an increased risk of being violently attacked or killed. You don't have to be unaware that a country with a declining population needs more young workers to oppose governments that welcome hundreds of thousands of immigrants hostile to your culture and uninterested in actually working

The gains for "far-right" parties may not change EU policies much, but they're likely to affect politically responsible national leaders. France's President Emmanuel Macron has called a snap two-round election.

French conservative party leader Eric Ciotti has

wanted me to master basic virtues — at the very least to master common sense — and I failed spectacularly.

It would have been easy had he been like the weak, hapless fathers portrayed on television these days.

But he was the opposite of weak. He was not afraid to discipline me and strengthen me to prepare me for the difficult challenges all of us must face in life.

My heart aches for so many children who are without direction, because they lack guidance from a cantankerous, masculine father who dresses them down, so he can build them back better — into polite, sensible, responsible human beings.

The way my father did when I flushed an apple core down the toilet in 1974.

### **Byron Donalds tells the truth** and the left hates it

Several weeks ago, Wall Street Journal columnist and former Reagan speechwriter Peggy Noonan wrote a column with the headline "We Are Starting to Enjoy Hatred.'

Her point was that, in our divided and polarized country, each side is no longer trying to "win over" those with whom they disagree. Sides are now just entrenched in hatred for each other.

It is impossible to not wake up and read the news, or simply walk out into the street into a demonstration, which is becoming business as usual in Washington, D.C., where I work, and not appreciate the truth of Noonan's observation.

As a Christian Black conservative, as I happen to be, dealing with personal attacks is something I accept as part of my business.

Now Florida Republican Rep. Byron Donalds, also a Black conservative, and someone whose name has been floated on Donald Trump's "short list" of possible VP running mates, is getting a taste of this unpleasantness.

At a recent Republican gathering in Philadelphia, Donalds observed, "During Jim Crow, the Black family was together. During Jim Crow, more Black people were not just conservative — because Black people have always been conservative-minded but more Black people voted conservatively. And then ... Lyndon Johnson



you go down that road, and now we are where we are.'

Any person endowed with the brain he or she has received from God, a willingness to use that brain and a modicum of good will to use reason in the pursuit of truth would grasp the point that Donalds was making that day.

Yet, Al Sharpton accused Donalds of saying Jim

Crow was a "good" or "better" time for Blacks. Liberal MSNBC commentator Joy Reid said Donalds suggested Jim Crow was a "golden era" for Blacks. Soon the Biden campaign and Democratic leadership picked up with similar shameful distortions of Donalds' remarks.

Donalds, of course, was not praising Jim Crow. He was lauding the strength and resilience of Black Americans to live their lives as productively as possible during those horrible times.

And he suggested that big government ushered in by Lyndon Johnson after the Civil Rights Act of 1964 hurt rather than helped Blacks.

Regarding Blacks voting more conservatively during the Jim Crow years, the data is clear.

From 1965, the first presidential election after the Civil Rights Act, to 2020, the average percent of Blacks voting Republican was 10.2%

But from 1936 to 1960, the average percent of Blacks voting Republican was 30%. In 1956, Republican Eisenhower received 39% of the Black vote.

Donalds' observation that Blacks voted more conservatively during the Jim Crow era is clear and correct.

Regarding the state of the Black family, Donalds' point that the Black family was healthier during the Jim Crow era is also crystal-clear.

Per data compiled by Pew Research from Census and American Community Survey data, in 1960, four years before the passage of the Civil Rights Act, 61% of Blacks age 18 and above were married. By 2021, this was down to 31%.

In June 1965, after the passage of the Civil Rights Act, Johnson spoke at prestigious Howard University to say that despite the new national civil rights law nullifying Jim Crow, and making racial discrimination unlawful, this, per Johnson, was not enough. Blacks were not ready, per Johnson, to be free.

In Johnson's words then, "But freedom is not enough. You do not wipe away the scars of centuries by saying: Now you are free to go where you want and do as you desire and choose the leaders you please.'

Donalds tells the truth that things went in the wrong direction after the Civil Rights Act — more rather than less government.

Those on the left are free to challenge his arguments. But that is done through rational and logical discussion.

But they choose not this path, because they will lose.

Dear Annie: My older brother and I family about this? have been dealing with a touchy situation for years. We are both adopted; our parents divorced when we were very young, and they both remarried.

When we try to tell her we don't want these mementos, she becomes defensive, even asking why. It's hard to put into words why my brother and I don't want these painful reminders of a man who didn't care about us and was abusive. Add to that, when we get together (not often, as they live out of state), our aunt and grandmother (who died recently) constantly bad-mouthed our mother about her issues and how she raised us. This took place at least once in front of my brother and my nephew, which was truly heartbreaking.

I sincerely believe my mother did the best she could, and we turned out OK. How do I confront my father's

I've tried telling my aunt straight out, but she gets defensive. Do I just grin and bear it in order to keep the peace?

Struggling Dear Struggling: Not wanting mementos of an abusive and absent father is very understand-


defensiveness has nothing to do with you and your brother and everything to do with her lack of compassion and empathy for the trauma that you endured as a result of your father's abuse.

While David couldn't explain the manner of God's omniscient (all-knowing) love, he could tell how it affected him: "Such knowledge is too wonderful for me: ... I cannot attain it" (Psalm 139:6, NKJV).


The psalmist acknowledges God is, indeed, in every place. "Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there" (Psalm 139:7-8, NIV). If one could climb to the highest heights or descend to the lowest depths, one couldn't escape the presence of Almighty God. This is what the omniscience


(all-knowing) and omnipresence (everywhere at once) of God means to us in practical terms. "If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast" (Psalm 139:9-10, NIV).

There's no point of space, inside or outside the bounds of creation, where God is not present. That's why when the question is asked, "Who's in control?" the answer without equivocation:" God is!'

### **Ex-Illinois hoops star Terrence** Shannon Jr., potential 1st-round NBA draft pick, not guilty of rape

Former Illinois standout Terrence Shannon Jr., a potential first-round NBA draft pick, was found not guilty Thursday on a rape charge after a jury in Douglas County, Kansas, spent less than two hours deliberating the verdict.


The 23-year-old Shannon was accused of committing sexual assault last September while visiting Kansas for a football game between the Illini and the Jayhawks. He was charged with rape or an alternative count of sexual battery, which led to him being suspended for six games; a federal judge later reinstated him, ruling that his civil rights had been violated.

Shannon testified that he joined two roommates and a few Kansas players at a bar on Sept. 8, 2023, but he only had a few drinks and remembered everything that happened that night. Shannon said he didn't learn of the rape allegation until several weeks later, and that he had never seen the 18-year-old woman who had accused him until the case had begun.

The woman told police she was at the bar

### **Jaguars extend Trevor Lawrence** to a 5-year, \$275M contract

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. (AP) - Trevor Lawrence is getting paid more for his potential than his performance.

Lawrence and the Jacksonville Jaguars agreed Thursday to a five-year, \$275 million contract extension that makes him one

of the highest-paid quarterbacks in NFL history, according to a person familiar with negotiations.

Lawrence's deal includes \$142 million fully guaran-teed and a \$37.5 million signing bonus, said the person who spoke to The Associated Press on condition of anonymity because neither side had announced the contract publicly.

Lawrence will get an average of \$55 million annually during the deal, tying him with Cincinnati's Joe Burrow for the most in NFL history.

EDMONTON, Alberta (AP) – Aleksander Barkov led the way offensively, Sergei Bobrovsky was in peak form in goal once again and the Florida Panthers are on the verge of lifting the Stanley Cup.

Barkov set up a goal and scored another, Bobrovsky made 32 saves to extend his run of dominance and the Panthers held on to beat the Edmonton Oilers 4-3 in Game 3 of the Cup final Thursday night.

They can win the first title in franchise history as soon as Game 4 on Saturday night on Edmonton.

Florida took another step toward hockey's mountaintop by pouncing on a handful of Edmonton turnovers and keeping Connor McDavid from scoring a goal. A late rally got the Oilers within one but fell short.

Long before that, Barkov forced one of the giveaways by Evan Bouchard seconds before Sam Reinhart's goal, netminder Stuart Skinner coughed up the puck on Vladimir Tarasenko's, and Darnell Nurse gave it away on Sam Bennett's.

Barkov had one of the signature moments by getting past the defense and beating Skinner on a breakaway, quieting for some time the crowd fired up for the first Stanley Cup Final game with fans in Edmonton since 2006.

It will take the Oilers completing a comeback done just four times in NHL playoff history - and once in the final all the way back in 1942 -to end Canada's Cup drought.

The last year a team based in Canada won it was Montreal in 1993, months before the Panthers' inaugural season. Until this series, they had gone 1-8 in the final.

Behind Barkov and Bobrovsky, Florida has totally flipped that script. The two leading candidates for the Conn Smythe Trophy as playoff MVP were arguably the two best players on the ice in Game 3, including Barkov bouncing back from a high hit from Leon Draistail that knocked him out of Game 2 on Monday night.

Another big reason the Panthers got here, winger Matthew Tkachuk, also had a big assist and was responsible for turning up the pressure on Edmonton.

The Oilers wilted under it, losing a game in which they largely the better team but could not overcome ill-timed miscues. Skinner allowed four goals on 23 shots and Connor Brown, Philip Broberg and Ryan McLeod scored, while McDavid for the first time all playoffs looked frustrated and out of sorts.

### IndyCar moves to Fox Sports in 2025 after 16 seasons with NBC

Fox Sports said Thursday it has acquired the rights to broadcast IndyCar starting in 2025, a move that gives the network two of the biggest races in the world — the Indianapolis 500 and NASCAR's Daytona 500.

Fox Sports already broadcasts the first half of the NASCAR schedule. NASCAR in November announced a seven-year media rights deal that added two new partners and streaming elements as the 38-race schedule is spread over multiple networks and platforms.

IndyCar said NBC Sports could not offer the same amount

NBC had held the rights to IndyCar since 2009 and its most recent three-year extension was believed to be worth \$20 million per season. But NBC Sports had moved coverage of all practices and qualifying sessions to its app, Peacock, and many of IndyCar's races have been on cable. Earlier this season, NBC moved the crown jewel race at Long Beach to USA Network and received just over 300,000 viewers; the race had
